ENROLLED SENATE RESOLUTION 54021 Fifty-Fourth Session

Summary: A resolution to formally support continuation of the Indian Child Welfare Act (ICWA) of

1978.

Legislation:

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court is reconsidering the precedent of ICWA; and

WHEREAS, if ICWA is overturned, Native people are at risk of genocide; and

WHEREAS, the overturn of ICWA will put NIU students, and all other Native people in the U.S. in danger; and

WHEREAS, the NIU Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion statement states "At NIU, we're committed to confronting racism and all forms of discrimination. We welcome all members of the campus community to join us in working toward positive change. By taking action, sharing resources, and providing support we can continue to find strength in our diversity."

THEREFORE, the students of Northern Illinois University represented in this Senate enact that the NIU Student Government Association has a responsibility to support Native students as well as fellow citizens of U.S. The NIU Student Government Association formally supports the continuation of ICWA.
